THE BRITISH PALOMINO AND DILUTE CLASSES

For dilutes and palomino's ponies of any breed or type, open to members and non members (excluding the Royal Welsh Agricultural Summer Show and The British Palomino National Championships where all palomino's and dilutes must be owned by a paid up member of the BPS and horses registered with the BPS) Members must display their membership disk in class in order to qualify if eligible and non members will be issued a card signed by the judge if qualification is awarded. All Gold silver and bronze cards are strictly awarded to members only in all classes. These classes are affiliated to THE BRITISH PALOMINO SOCIETY and are run under their rules, please refer to <u>www.thebritishpalominosociety.co.uk</u>
