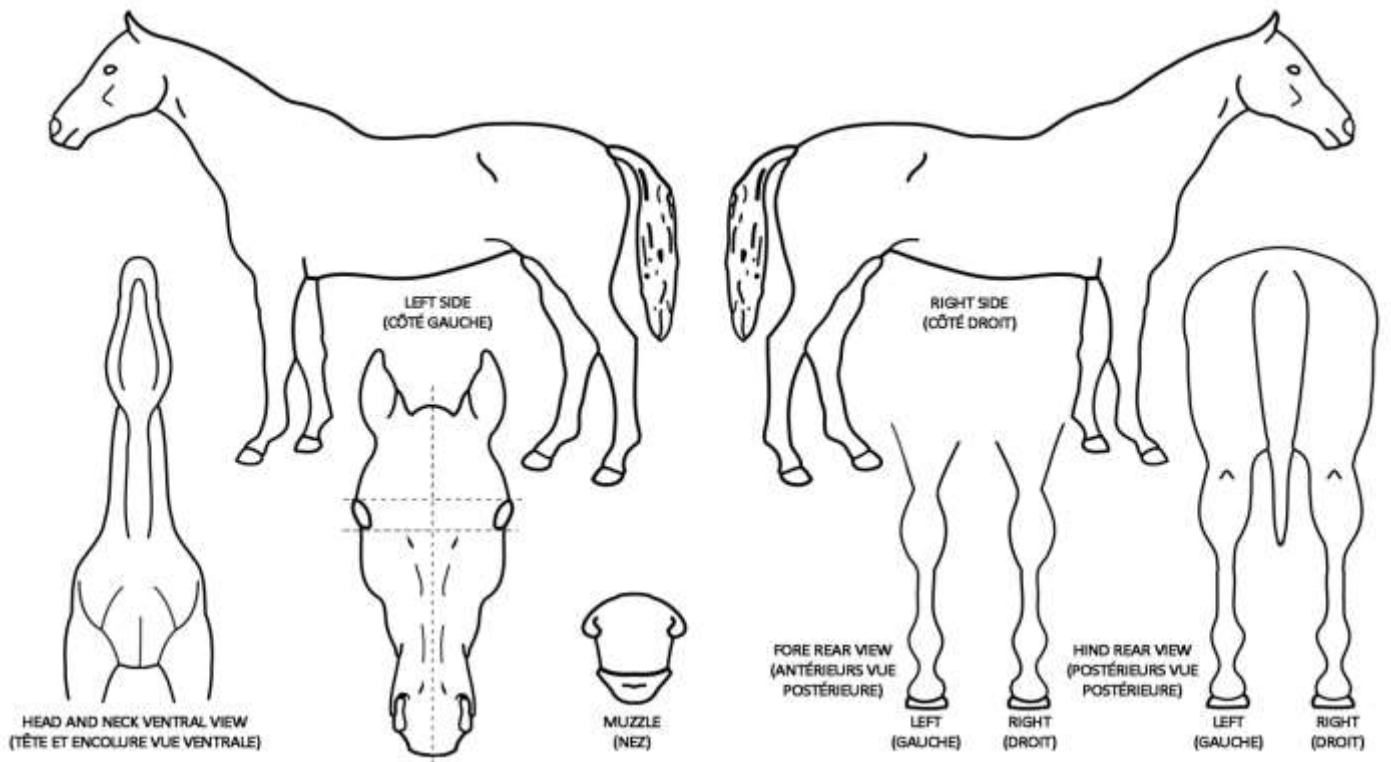

BUYING AN EQUINE

In the case of The British Palomino Society you will need to send the completed form, the equine passport and the correct fee to the PIO (address is in bold print on the front of all forms).
